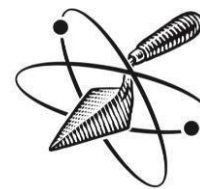

Conferences and awards sponsored during the reporting period (May 2024 – May 2025)

- May 2024: **ARCAS/ISA 2024 conference** (Melbourne, Australia): SAS funded one ARCAS 2024 Best Paper Award; two R.E. Taylor Student Poster Awards.
- June 2024: **Landscape Archaeology Conference (LAC) 2024** (Madrid, Spain): SAS funded one poster award for a student/ECR.
- September 2024: **CLASMAC 2024 conference** (Mexico City, Mexico): SAS funded two awards—one student poster award and one student oral presentation award.
- October 2024: **Young Researchers in Archaeometry (YRA) 2025 conference** (Nicosia, Cyprus): SAS funded one student/ECR travel award.
- October 2024: **FACSS SciX 2024 conference** (Raleigh, USA): SAS funded the registration fees for three student invited speakers at the annual session on Student Research in Archaeological Chemistry.
- April 2025: **GMPCA 25th symposium, Archéométrie 2025** (Rouen, France): SAS funded one student poster award.
- April 2025: **Society for American Archaeology 90th Annual Meeting** session: “Ceramics and Archaeological Sciences” (Denver, USA): Symposium sponsored and organized by SAS and is an annual feature of the SAA meeting.
