

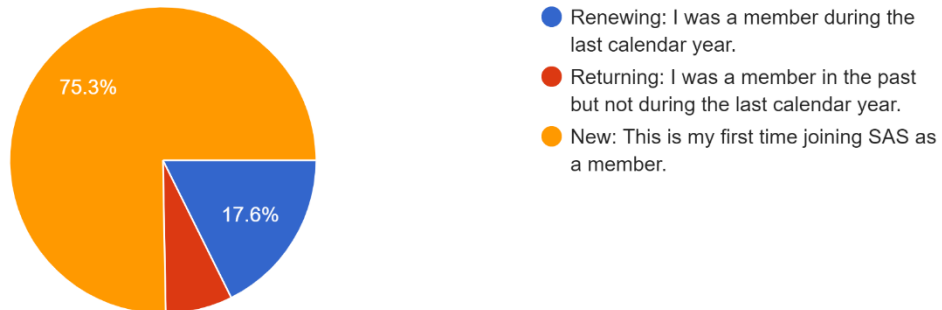

In 2023, I incorporated three new features into the website: a member spotlight form, a paper spotlight form, and a member information form. 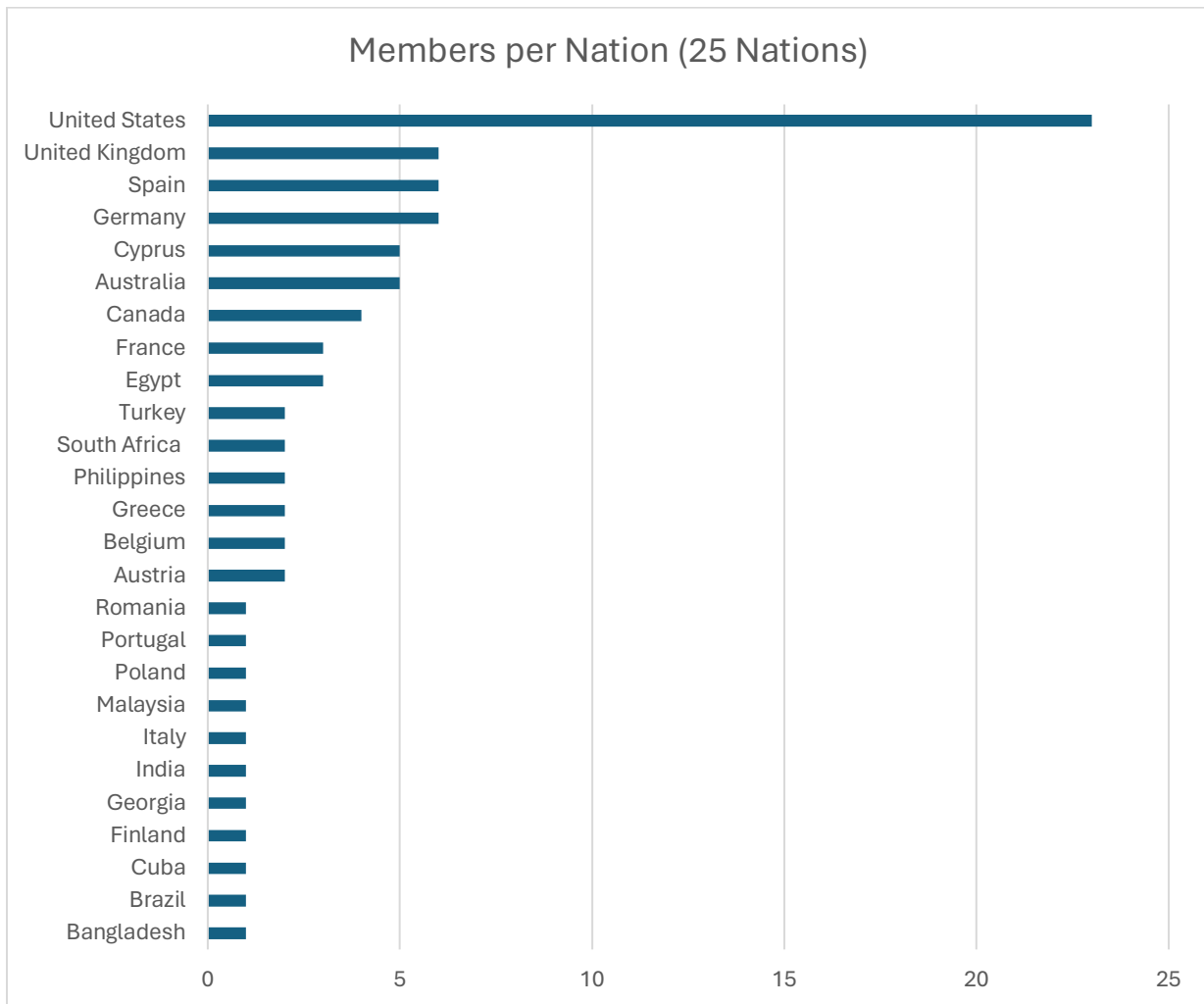
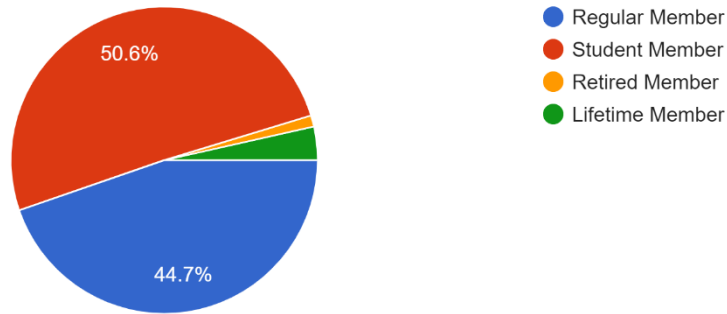
Are you a renewing member, a returning member, or a new member?

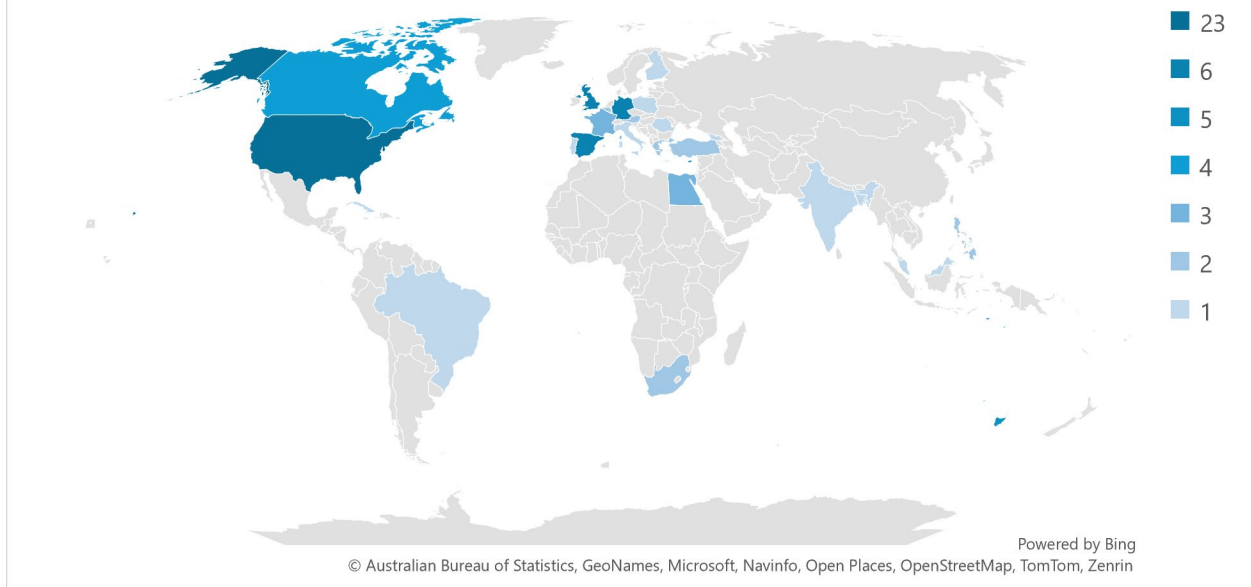


What membership level are you selecting? Please note that you will still need to select a membership tier and pay the applicable dues separately if you are an existing Lifetime member and exempt from dues.

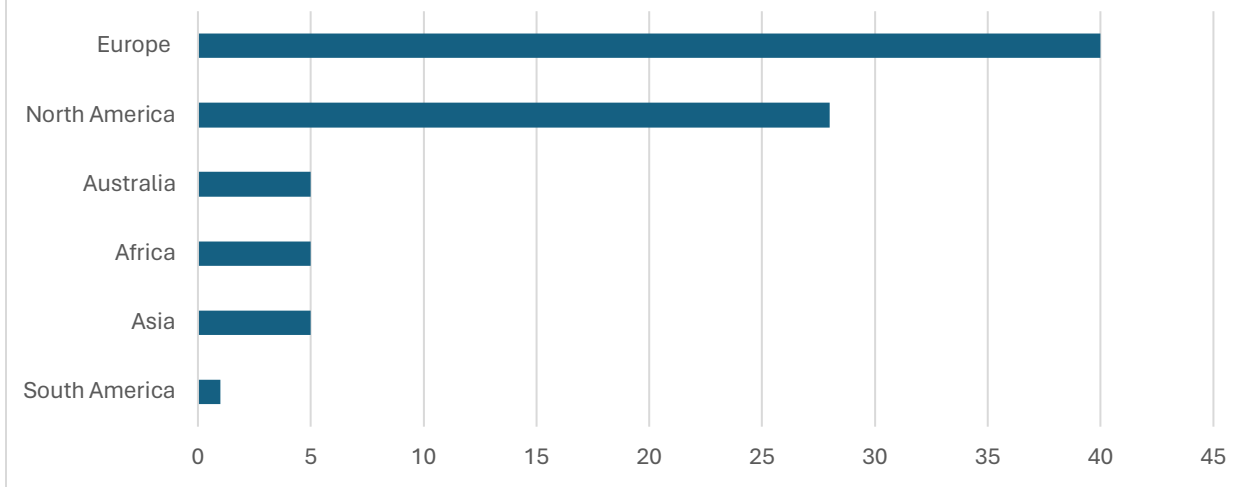

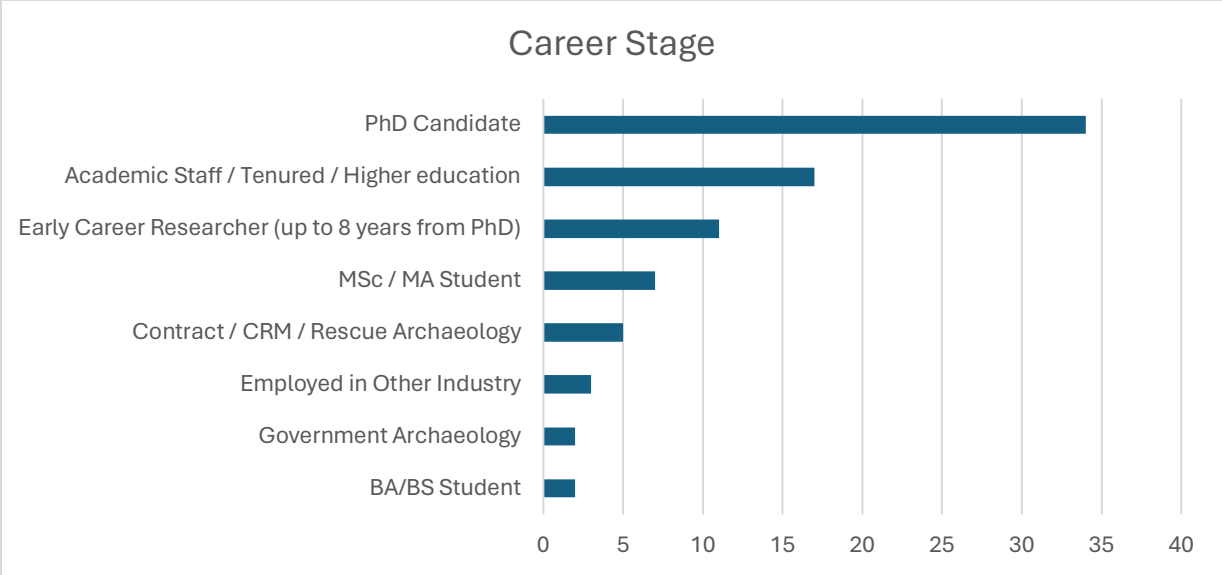


### SAS Members per Country



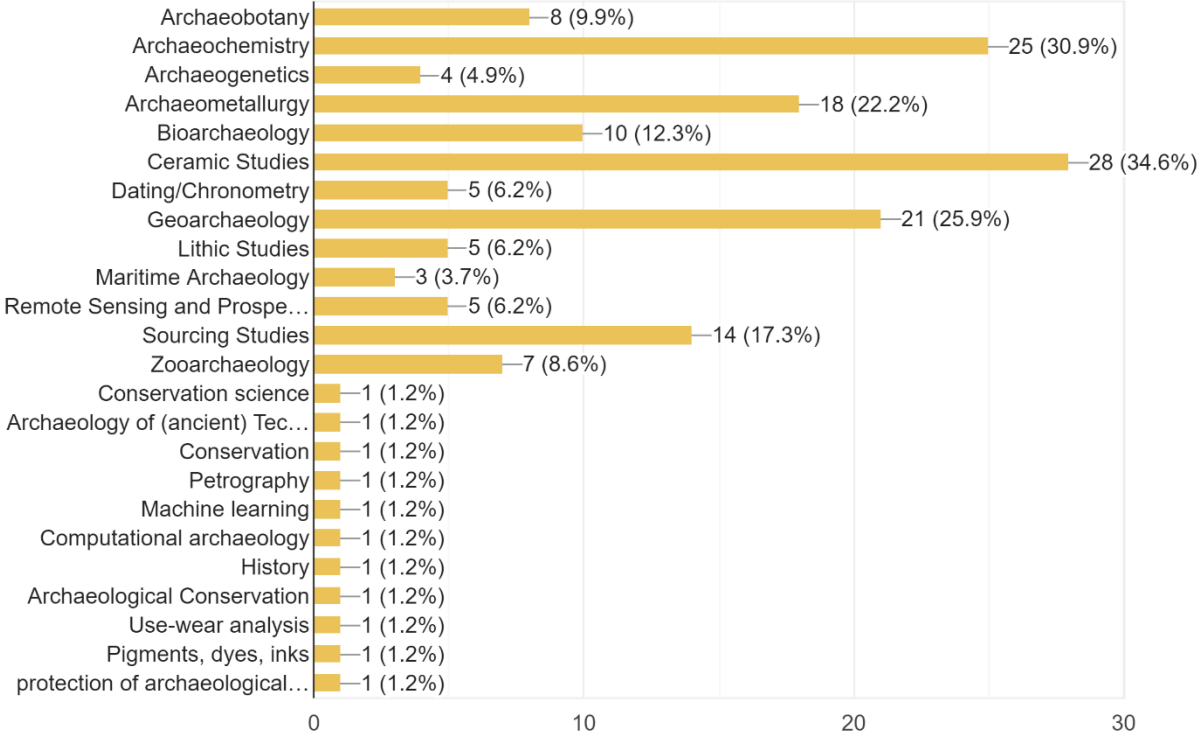
### Members per Continent





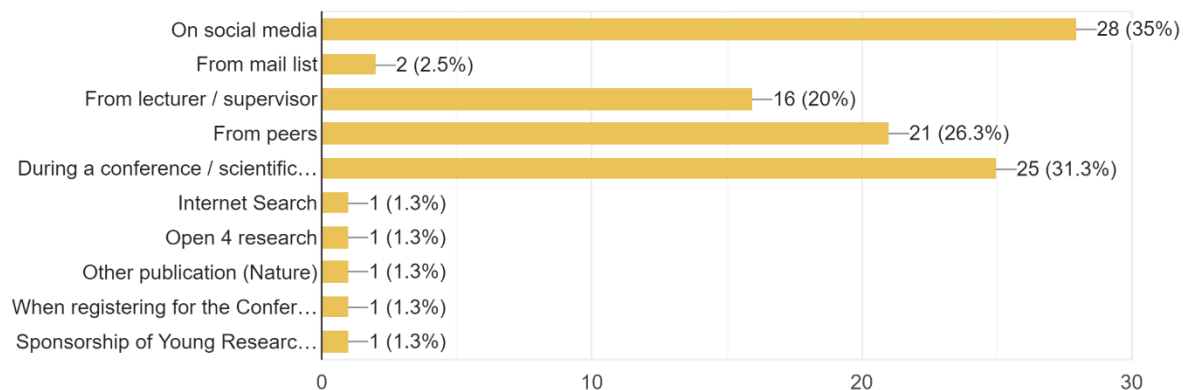
### What is your research field? (optional)
