The SAS General Secretary functions to maintain the membership database, run the annual renewal process, handle taxes, tally the bi-annual elections, and tend to a variety of other general business for the Society.

For the membership database, we are using Microsoft Access. SAS membership numbers from 2023 are slightly lower than 2022, but are up over the past five years. The membership breakdown in 2022 included 101 Regular members, 93 Lifetime members, 67 Student members, and 8 Retired members. Roughly 49% of our membership in 2022 was from the United States, followed by Europe (non-UK) at 22%, and the UK at 8%. Note that the current numbers from 2022 show that about 52% of our membership is from the U.S.

Banking is done with Decorah Bank & Trust Co. in Decorah, Iowa. Membership payments have been made using PayPal or by check.
